Dear Friends,

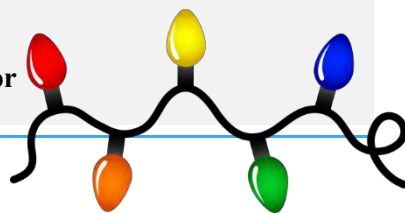
